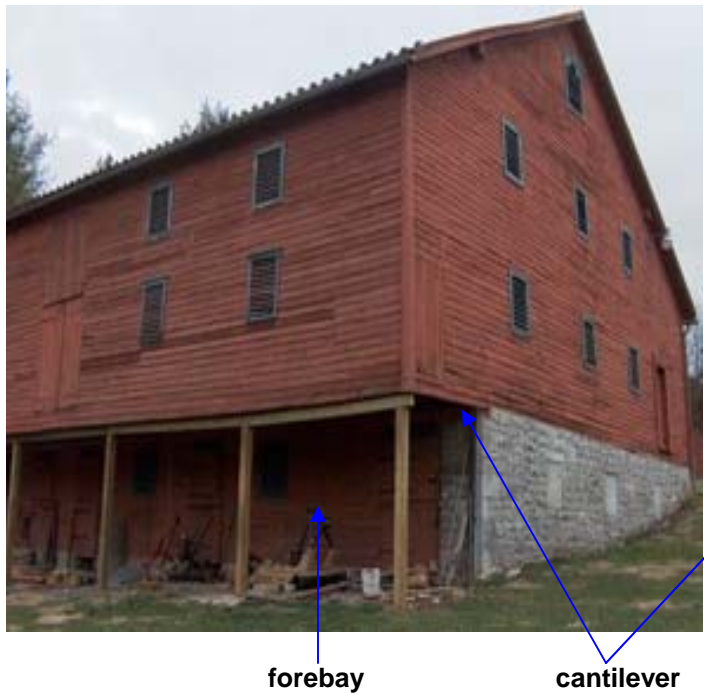
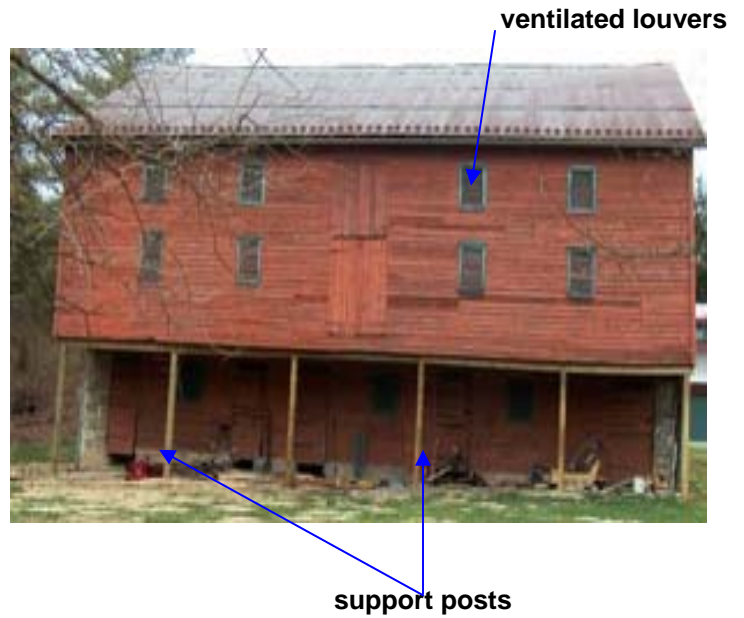
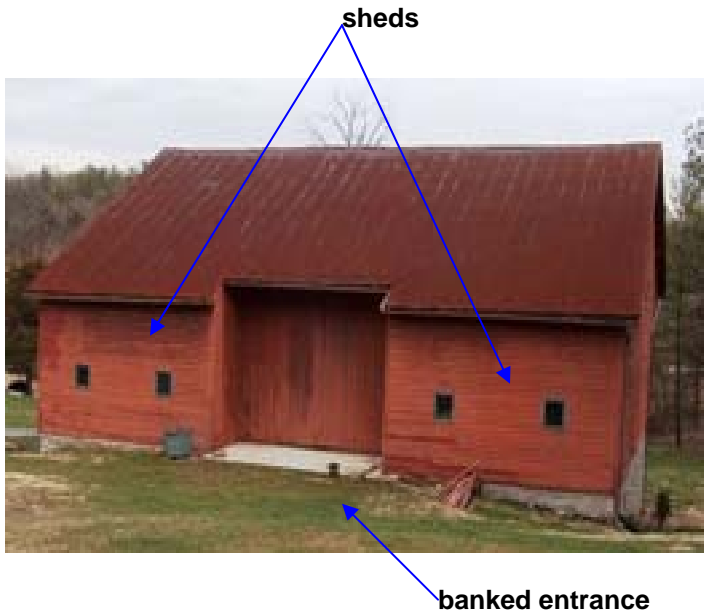


Teacher Guide 1: The Pennsylvania Barn



Identify the following in the pictures above and explain their function as part of a Pennsylvania Barn

cantilever: supported only on one end; allows for open overhang

forebay: projection over the lower level doors to protect them from the weather.

banked entrance: built into the ground (or bank) so that wagons, equipment, supplies, and crops could be easily moved into the second floor.

support posts: posts separate from foundation for support

ventilated louvers: allow air circulation with some protection from the elements

sheds: Located on either side of the main entrance, they provide additional storage space.
